Process: Americhem improved operational efficiency through site-level water reduction efforts and continued its shift toward renewable energy. The company now sources 100% renewable electricity for its world headquarters in Ohio and reduced greenhouse gas emissions at several global sites through certified renewable energy sourcing, including participation in a Green-e® certified program.

Product: Sustainability-driven product innovation accelerated with the launch of EcoLube[™] MD, a PFAS-free internally lubricated compound developed for the
